

Havana Public Library District Mask Policy

As per Executive Order 20-32, public buildings require face coverings during all phases below Phase 5 in the Restore Illinois Plan.

All persons over the age of two entering the library must wear a mask or face covering and must maintain a six foot distance from other patrons when practicable, and when requested by staff.

Reasonable accommodations such as curbside service and online resources are available to those who are medically prevented from or decline to wear a face covering. Those refusing to wear a face covering and/or to maintain six-foot distance will be asked to leave the library. Police will be called if confrontations seem imminent. This policy shall be lifted automatically when the Illinois Department of Public Health declares that the state has reached Phase 5 of the Restore Illinois plan. The policy shall be reinstated automatically should the Illinois Department of Public Health determine that the state must return to any phase lower than Phase 5 of the Restore Illinois plan.
